Supplementary to the curriculum, our secondary school offers diverse full-day courses such as: theatre, gospel choir, sports or the school radio. In addition, students are provided the opportunity to participate in projects (such as the stock exchange business game) and are able to better understand the complex interrelationships via our international school partnerships.

In accordance with the Brandenburg School Act classes from 7 through to 10 are offered.

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
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What we offer
